#### \*A Note About Clothing\*

All clothing items should be worn in good taste and should not draw unnecessary attention. Please be considerate when choosing bathing suits and other "casual" clothing. Directors and chaperones have the right to request that a student change at any time if they feel that clothing is not suitable or appropriate.

### **Luggage / Items To Bring**

- You are permitted to bring TWO checked bags and ONE carry-on. Remember, packing light is the way to go on a trip...especially if you plan to bring additional items home. You must be able to carry all of your own luggage, without assistance.
  - Weight/Size: Maximum weight is <u>50 pounds</u> and maximum size is 62 inches (length + width + height) per check piece of luggage. Overweight items from 51 to 100 pounds and oversized items in excess of 62 inches but not more than 80 inches will be accepted for an overweight and oversize baggage fee of \$75 per item. <u>Full details</u>.
  - Travel Ban: Lithium batteries that are damaged, defective, or recalled for safety reasons are not allowed in checked baggage, carryon baggage, or cargo.
  - **Ouch!:** Please make sure that any sharp objects (especially needles, syringes, and other items needed for medication) are properly covered and secured to prevent injury to yourself and our Employees who care for your bags.
  - Carry-On/Personal Items: Carryon items are limited to one bag plus one smaller, personal-type item. Southwest Airlines limits carryon bag dimensions to 10 x 16 x 24 inches. All Customers and Employees and their items are subject to a thorough physical search. Personal-type items include purses, briefcases, cameras, food containers, or laptops (case included). Your personal item must be stored under the seat in front of you.

  - Spending money for souvenirs & some food

We recommend bringing \$200 for extraneous expenses. Less is okay, more is okay.

### **Medications**

- All medication (including non-prescription) must be properly labeled, and in the
  original container. Prescription medication must include on the label the name of
  the student, name of the medication, the dosage, and time the medication is to be
  administered.
- Every student must have a signed OVER THE COUNTER or PRESCRIBED Medication form on file. This form also counts as the "Medical Release" form.
- Please make your room chaperone aware of any medical condition that could need treatment asthma, diabetes, etc.

### **Condo Rules**

- Nobody should enter rooms of the opposite gender. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Please respect the other guests of the condo by not making excessive noise in the hallways/public areas. Visit friends in the lobby or other meeting areas, not in the corridor.
- Each evening you will be given a time for Room Checks. After your room check you
  cannot leave your room for any reason. This includes going next door to your
  chaperones room to pickup something you forgot! This includes going back to the
  lobby to get water or a snack!
- Lights-out means that no lights are on, no phone calls, everyone in bed.
- Use your personal cell phones to communicate with your parents. Do not use room phones for any reason. Phones in the rooms will be blocked.
- You are not permitted to leave the condo property for any reason unless directed to do so by Mr. Sieloff.
- Chaperones may not take students outside of condo property without the consent of Mr. Sieloff.
